Ranting and raving within the public arena will not be tolerated by anyone involved with the Ballarat Football Netball League and we will be following up on all incidents from the weekend and many people will be receiving a "please explain" from the league for their actions over the weekend.

Parents & Supporters Code Of Conduct:

Clubs should be aware of the BFNL's Parent & Supporters Code of Conduct and hopefully promoting it on your website and to all of your members. Important points taken from the Code of Conduct are as follows:

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability you'll let down your family and yourself if you do & many such comments are actually now illegal.
